

Our mission school in Haiti now completely runs off of solar power. We have a 200' deep well in the center of our compound. Our last stage of phase 1 is to install a \$20,000 filtration/bottling system which will finally make them self sufficient. The villagers whose kids make up our school of 350 kids are 80% unemployed and so therefore cannot afford to pay for their schooling. We are the only school in Haiti that lets them come to school even if they cannot afford to pay. We are running a deficit of about \$5,000/mo to pay for 18 school teachers (\$150/mo) food etc to run the school. If we install this bottling system then we can sell 5 gal jugs of water to the villagers at \$1.00 ea and then they can take them to the larger cities and sell them for \$1.50 each thereby helping with the unemployment issue. This system will fill up to 800 jugs /day. If they just sell 200/day x 30 days a month it will generate \$6,000/mo for the school solving our deficit.

Pastor Willy Severe is coming home next week for medical issues and to see his family. I am asking for prayer and support to raise this \$20,000 by June 7 to buy and install this system for when Pastor Willy will be going back to Haiti.
